Bus & Equipment/Trailer Parking

We will have designated bus and trailer parking on or near the campus. There will be signs and volunteers who will guide your drivers upon arrival at the school. If you have a prop trailer, let us know so that we can direct you to the appropriate location.

Directors & Staff Hospitality Room

We will have a designated area for Directors and select staff to enter for snacks, beverages and other refreshments.

Staging and Warm-Up

Staging and warm-up areas are all located within the LRHS campus as shown on the campus map provided with your welcome packet. They are well lit and connected by wide sidewalks and roadways to the Lakewood Ranch Stadium.

Please adhere to the warm-up schedule and location provided. Your band guide is your point of contact if accommodations are required or changes occur.

Incident Weather Plans

While we hope for a nice sunny day, we are in Florida. The safety of the members and spectators is our main concern and we know you will understand any delays or changes in schedule due to dangerous weather. The gymnasium will be available to host a modified competition in the event it is unsafe to be outdoors.

Hydration, Medical, and Safety

There will be a staffed first aid station/tent provided within the LRHS stadium for minor treatments. We will have clean, cold water at each of the warm-up areas and at the entrance to the stadium.

Power

Power will be provided at the 50 yard line within the stadium and at the Percussion warm-up areas.

Special Transportation Accommodations

If you have any members who will require special transportation to the warm-up area, staging, or performance field, we will be offering a special needs golf cart to assist them in their movement. We ask that the Band Director inform us at check-in so we can get the cart to your location.

Judges Critique

Opportunity to get direct feedback from the judges will be provided at the conclusion of the show.

Concessions
